- Please note that the presentation of a valid vaccination certificate is now required to enter the IWC in line with new government Covid-19 guidelines. Your vaccine cert will be checked at the door, and you will be checked for photo ID matching your cert.
- We require that both our staff and Members wear face covering in shared spaces. You may take your mask off when you are settled into the room that you have booked. Please make sure you wear yours from before entering the building until after leaving the building. You can find the HSE's latest updates on face masks and coverings below:
- Please arrive at the exact time of appointment and ring the door bell. Our main door is currently closed. One of the IWC Team will go out to greet you and let you in.
- Please ensure to check in at reception, to check your room booking and we are still serving teas and coffees so you may bring your refreshment with you to the allocated room.
- Hand sanitiser must be used on entry to the building and before leaving. Hand sanitiser stations are available at each floor and at entry and exit points.
